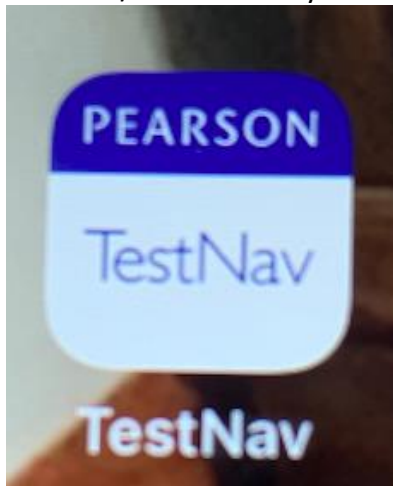


Junior ACT Student Tutorial & Practice Instructions:
