

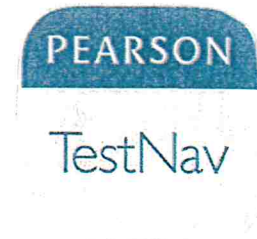
Please review the following Aspire Test information with students on Tuesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> during ELT:

### 1. General Testing Information

- Notify students of their testing room and room supervisor(see attached roster)
- Testing is online using the TestNav app. **Students MUST have their ipad charged.**
- Phones are not allowed. Phones should be in a locker or car for the entirety of the test. You can store them, turned off, at your desk if necessary.
- Students should bring pencils or pens, calculator and a book to read(book is optional). Water and snacks are allowed during breaks and must be kept in the back of the room. Students are responsible for bringing their own snacks.
- Aspire scores can help teachers measure growth in subject areas from year to year and is one tool to measure readiness for college success. It is also practice for standardized test taking.
